The food pantry is now open on Friday from 11am – 1pm to distribute these goods to anyone interested. Help is needed during the hours that it is open. Various people are making trip to pick up the items.

Education – 16 Sunne kids and 2 local kids are registered for Camp of the Cross. Confirmation Camping is moved to August 5-7, 2019.
