I always love this time of year. All of the fields are planted, and we have received some nice rain, and it now time to watch things grow. It always astonishes me that from a little seed such big things can grow. However, with a crop you can't just plant the seed and walk away. You need to keep an eye on the process and do your part along the way. The sign up sheet is located on the table by the office. Please sign up.

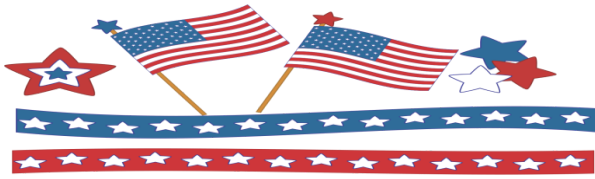
